The C J La Trobe Society Inc. was established in 2001 to promote recognition and understanding of the achievements of Charles Joseph La Trobe, Superintendent of the Port Phillip District of New South Wales from 1839 and the first Lieutenant Governor of the new colony of Victoria after separation in 1851, until his departure in 1854.

The Society celebrates La Trobe's birthday annually, around 20 March, hosts lectures, arranges functions throughout the year and a Christmas Cocktail Party at one of the city clubs each year. The Society publishes a journal, 'La Trobeana' three times a year, with historic articles and information about forthcoming events.

The Society aims to endow a La Trobe Society Fellowship each year under the umbrella of the State Library of Victoria, to research and record aspects of the colonial period of Victoria's history.
