HERE RESTS IN THE LORD THE BODY OF CHARLES JOSEPH LA TROBE, ESQ^{RE}, C.B. FIRST LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE COLONY OF VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA, WHO DIED AT CLAPHAM HOUSE, IN THIS PARISH, 4TH DECEMBER 1875, AGED 74, THINE EYES SHALL SEE THE KING IN HIS BEAUTY ISAIAH XXXIII.17.

Professor John Barnes remarks: 'Only the first part of the verse from Isaiah, so poignantly appropriate to La Trobe, is quoted: the words 'they shall behold the land that is very far off' are omitted.
