

Sophie La Trobe (1810-1854) – birth, death and marriage

Mon père Charles Joseph La Trobe, est né le 20 Mars 1801 à Londres. - mort le 4 Dec. 1875 à Clapham House Littleington, Sussex.
Ma mère Sophie de Montmollin est née le 8 Février 1810 à Neuchâtel, où elle est morte le 30 Janvier 1854.
Mes parents se sont mariés à Berne à la Légation Anglaise le 16 Septembre 1835, et ont passé leur lieu de miel à Jolimont, près Cestien, appartenant alors au Comte Frédéric de Pourtales-Castellane.
(Mes deux grands pères, Che. Ign. La Trobe et Frédéric Auguste de Montmollin, sont morts en 1836. L'un à Fairfield, près Manchester; l'autre à Neuchâtel.

Ñ Journal of Agnes de Salis, née La Trobe, extract

My father Charles Joseph La Trobe, was born on 20th March 1801 in London – died on 4th December 1875 at Clapham House, Litlington, Sussex.

My mother Sophie de Montmollin was born 8th February 1810 in Neuchâtel, where she died on 30th January 1854.

My parents were married in Berne at the English Legation on 16th September 1835, and they spent their honeymoon at Jolimont, near Cerlier, an estate of Count Frederic de Pourtalès-Castellane.

Ñ Extract from the Register of Deaths in Neuchâtel

On Wednesday 1st February 1854 Sophie, née de Montmollin, was buried. She was the wife of Charles Joseph Latrobe, an Englishman, Governor of Melbourne in Australia. Born 9th [sic] February 1810, died 30th January of a chronic inflammation of the liver, and apoplexy; daughter of Frédéric Auguste de Montmollin and of Rose Augustine, née de Meuron, his wife.

Performed in accordance with the Register by us, civil official of the Neuchatel district. At Neuchatel, the eighth September, eighteen hundred and fifty-five.
